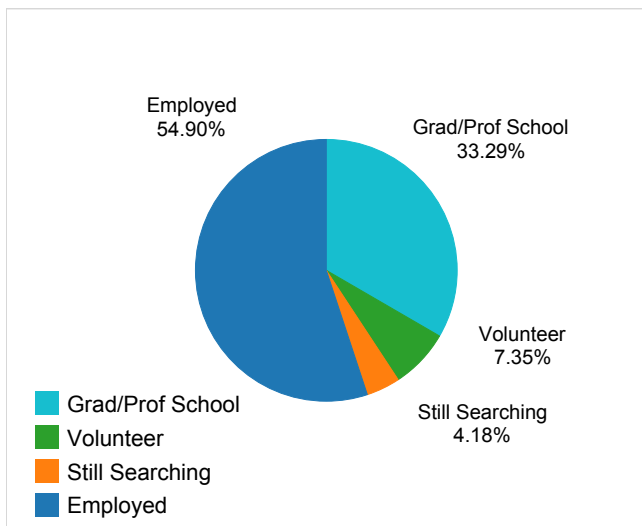




Graduate Outcomes 2012-2013

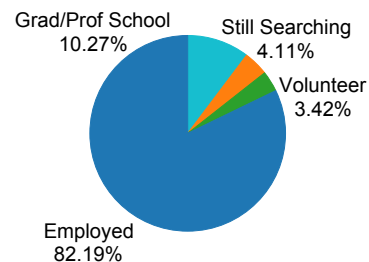
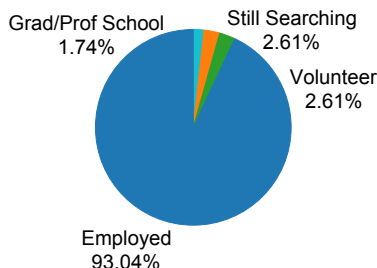
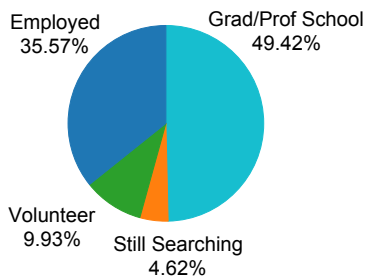

Creighton Graduates' Median Salaries By College

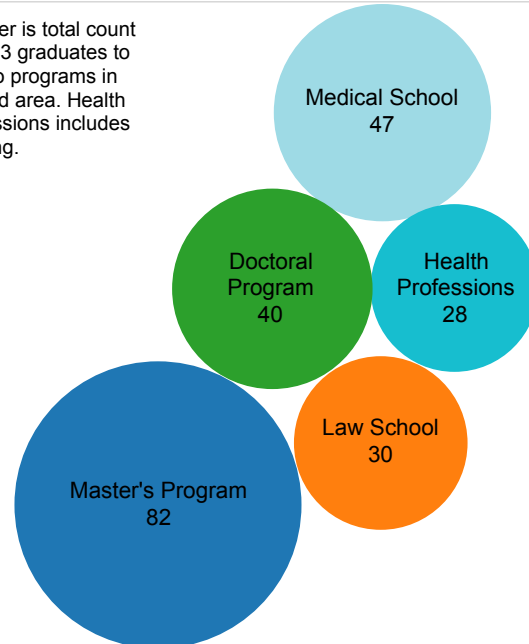


Median salaries for Creighton graduates from all three undergraduate colleges are very competitive with national averages despite the fact that many students locate to Midwest cities where the cost of living is much lower than the national average. The highest salaries reported for all three colleges were between \$69,000 and \$75,000.

More than 32% of the entire graduating class was successfully accepted into graduate or professional school, with the highest representation from the College of Arts and Sciences at 49%. When taking into account students who intended to pursue further education after a year of volunteer work or take more courses to be competitive for admission, that figure increases to 55-60%.

What types of Graduate & Professional Programs do Creighton graduates go into?

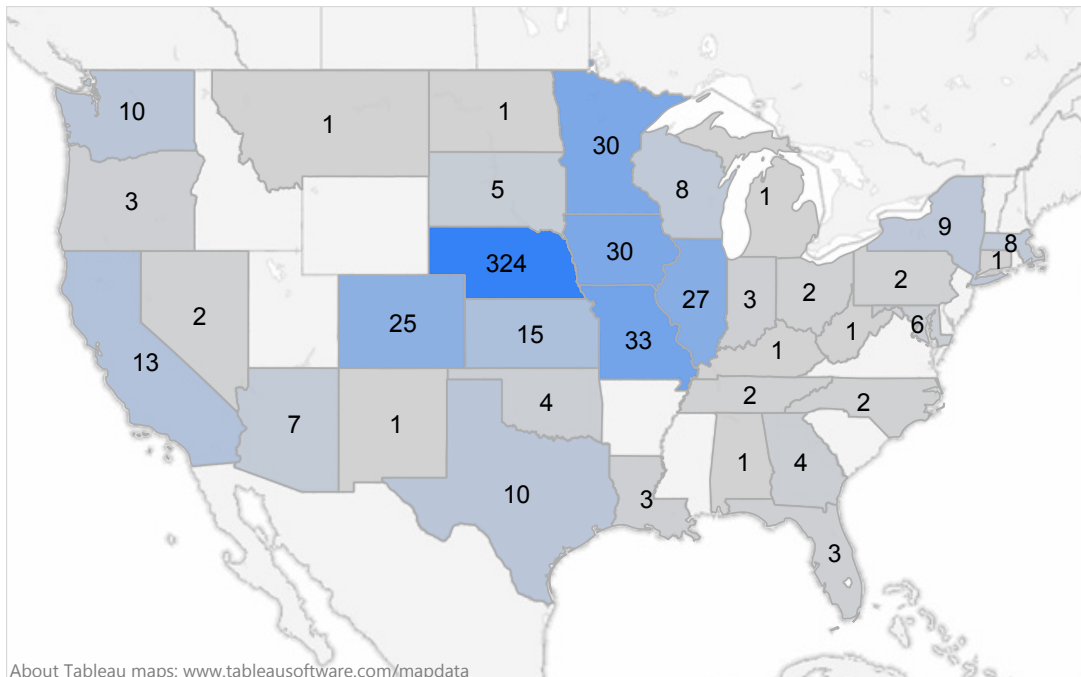
