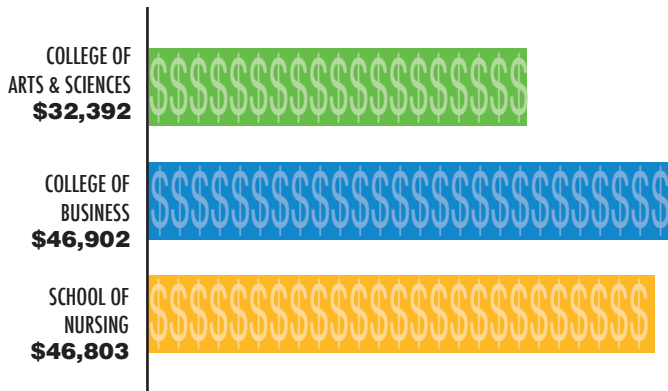


OUTCOMES

CREIGHTON GRADUATES SALARIES BY COLLEGE (AVG)



Business Administration graduates enjoyed a 4% increase in salary over last year while School of Nursing salaries exceeded last year's average by 6.5%.

Salary averages for all three undergraduate schools and colleges are very competitive with national averages despite the fact that most students are locating to Midwest cities where the cost of living is much lower than national averages.

The Creighton Career Center professionals develop strong relationships with students throughout their careers and successfully track alumni for career information as they graduate. Our 81 percent response rate is significantly higher than those received by schools comparable to Creighton. Nationally, colleges report less than 50 percent response rates for graduating seniors, which can cause rate inflation. Recent graduates respond to surveys at a higher rate when they have a job offer or are enrolled in graduate/professional school.

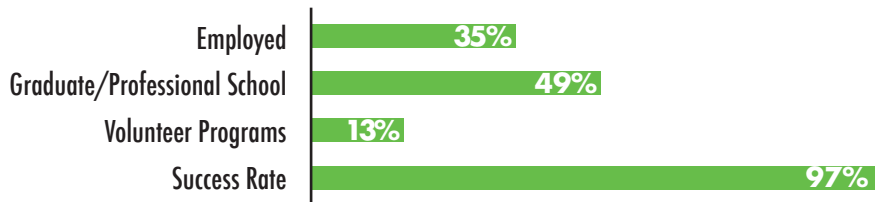
CREIGHTON GRADUATES OVERALL SUCCESS RATE

The overall success rate for all undergraduate colleges nine months after graduation is 96.16%. This is nearly 3% better than the overall success rate for 2010-11 grads. Creighton's 96% success rate is significantly higher than the national average, which is in the 70-80% range.



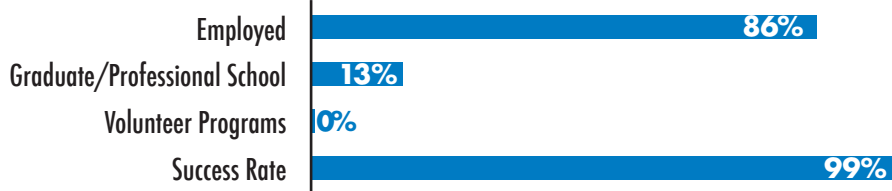
CREIGHTON GRADUATES OUTCOMES BY COLLEGE

COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES



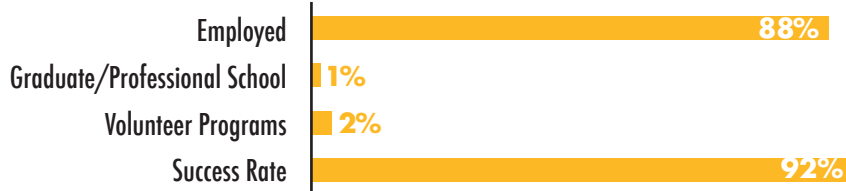
The College of Arts and Sciences success rate for this year's class is nearly 97%, an improvement of more than 5% over last year.

COLLEGE OF BUSINESS



The success rate for College of Business graduates exceeded 98% and improved by 1% over 2010-11.

SCHOOL OF NURSING



The Nursing success rate was 92% for 2011-12 graduates, with a NCLEX (Nat. Council Licensure Examination) pass rate of 95%, which is well above the national average.
