Comments

- This is a 95% success rate within eight months of graduation.
 - This summary is based on a response rate of 85% of 2007-2008 graduates who reported their status. This response rate is much greater than most surveys done by career centers around the country.
 - Creighton salary data is very competitive with regional and national averages despite the fact that most of our grads take their first jobs in cities with a lower standard of living than those in their cohort group. Average salaries for Nursing graduates rose more than 15% – significantly greater than the national rise in Nursing salaries.
 - This summary includes self-reported data from Dec. '07, May, '08 and Aug. '08 bachelor's degree recipients.
 - While 49% of our Arts and Sciences graduates pursue graduate or professional school immediately after graduation, if the survey data were to include the group that pursues advanced study after 1-2 years, this percentage would approach 60%.

Special Note: *Despite the challenges in the current economy, campus recruiting activity of employers that hire Creighton interns and graduates has not slowed during the 2008-09 academic year. This is outstanding evidence of the quality of a Creighton education as perceived by employers who hire Creighton students.*
