


This issue of the Research Bulletin examines some of the differences among the 2015 entering full-time freshmen by college of enrollment. Nine hundred forty (940) freshmen participated in the survey, 88% of the entering class; 63% indicated they were in the Creighton College of Arts and Sciences (CCAS), 26% indicated Heider College of Business (HCB), and 11% indicated College of Nursing (CON). It is helpful to note however that these published data and findings pertain mainly to Creighton's first-time, full-time freshman cohort who participated in the freshman survey (  ). The National Norm (NORM) reported are based upon 141,189 first-time, full-time students who entered 199 four-year U.S. colleges and universities of varying selectivity and type.
