


## Task Bar

Several menu changes are being made to streamline the tool bar and free up space for future enhancements to be added.


The task bar will now appear at the top of the screen, above the CUBuyplus logo.



Tasks will now appear as a double box with a checkmark. Access the drop down menu by moving your cursor over the box, just as it does today.



A person icon will now appear which combines the below items in a single location.




## Marketplace


The search field for searching the entire site for a product or service has a new look.



The drop down on the right will bring up the below menu. Supplier Categories are now called Tag. Remember that Category is referring to the UNSPCS (United Nations Standard Products and Services Code®) product category.



Supplier Tags was formerly called Category. A Category here referred to groupings of suppliers that were setup for a department to be able to further refine their search. Supplier Tags will continue to have the department groupings and has been expanded to include items such as sustainability and women owned.



Additional information will now appear when looking at suppliers.

- Folder indicates that the supplier has a hosted catalog, which means that the catalog is stored in the tool.
- The double arrow means that the supplier has the ability to receive the order electronically rather than automated email or snail mail.
- The circling arrow means the supplier has a punchout catalog, which means that CUBuyplus will go out to the supplier's site for shopping and then brings the purchases back into the users shopping cart.
