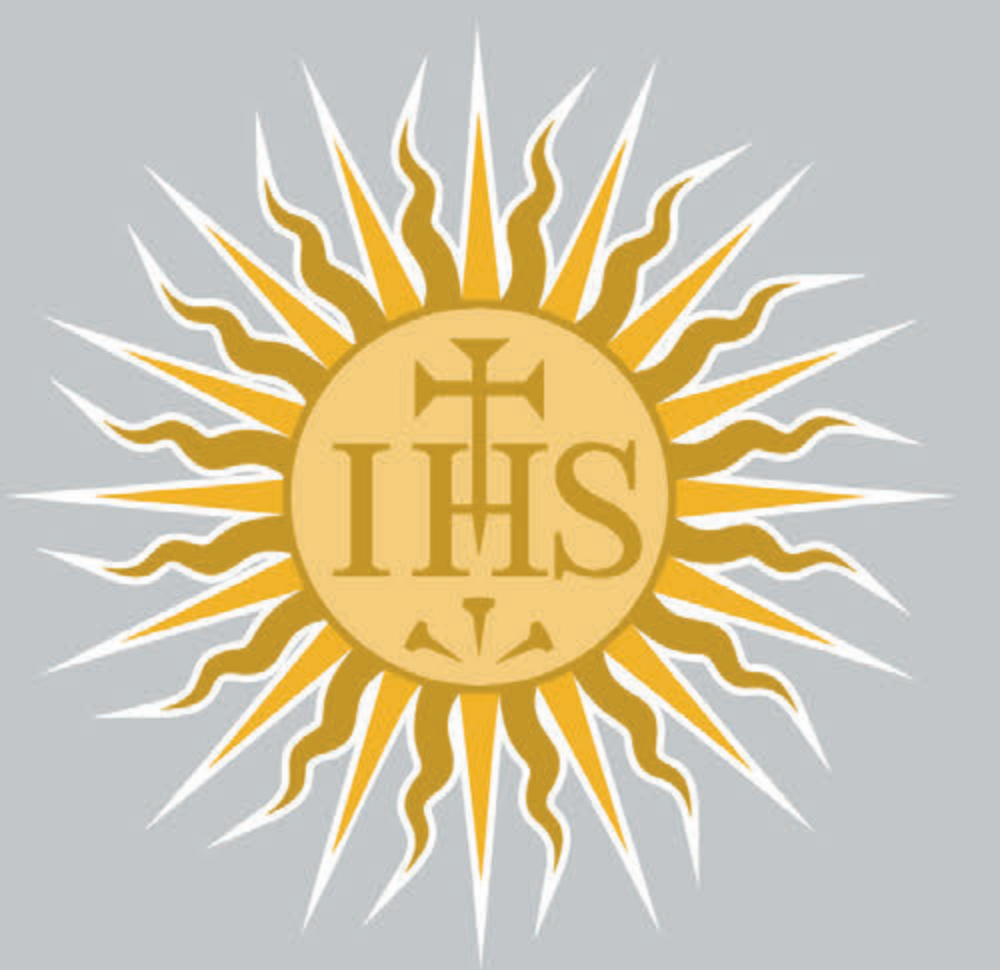




# All Things Ignatian
