### FULL-TIME STATUS

- ➡ For students in Arts & Sciences, College of Business, Traditional Nursing, and University College  
Full-Time status = 12 to 18 credit hours. Additional credit hours are assessed at the per credit hour rate corresponding to their assessed tuition rate.
- ➡ For students in Pharmacy, Pharmacy Web, Occupational Therapy, and Physical Therapy, students are responsible for full-time semesters in which they are enrolled and completing required didactic or clinical course work, including summers.
- ➡ For Accelerated Nursing and RN to BSN Program  
Full-Time status = 12 or more credit hours.
- ➡ For Law students  
Full-Time status = 10 or more credit hours. Law students also pursuing Graduate School degree will be assessed Graduate School tuition at a per credit hour rate for each Graduate class they take in addition to their Law School tuition.
- ➡ For Graduate School  
Full-Time status = 8 or more credit hours. All hours are assessed on a per credit hour basis

### QUALIFICATION FOR FINANCIAL AID

Undergraduate students must be pursuing a degree and registered for at least 6 credit hours per semester to qualify for financial aid.  
Graduate students must be pursuing a degree and registered for at least 3 credit hours per semester to qualify for financial aid.
