

# Theatre of the Deaf to perform 'Musketeers'

The National Theatre of the Deaf, winner of the 1977 Tony award for theatrical excellence, will perform "The Three Musketeers," Thursday at 8 p.m. in Brandeis Student Center.

The new program is adapted from the novel by Alexander Dumas.

"In the United States the company has given over 1,500 performances in 46 states, including two Broadway performances," according to David Hays, director of the company.

He said more than 100 million Americans have seen the National Theatre of the Deaf on television. The company's most notable appearance, he said, was in the CBS Christmas special, "A Child's Christmas in Wales," co-starring Michael Redgrave.

The company has also appeared in Canada, Denmark, England, France, Italy and other countries.

The company blends mime, dance, music and song with graceful sign language.

The 12-actor company directs its entertainment

to both hearing and deaf audiences. Three hearing actors provide the spoken words and song.

"The Three Musketeers," directed by Joe Layton, celebrates the company's 10th anniversary.

The company will also conduct two workshops Thursday, both at 2 p.m. They will be held at the Omaha Community Playhouse and the Iowa School for the Deaf.

General admission for the performance is \$2.50, \$1 with a Creighton I.D. Advance tickets may be purchased at the office of the Dean of Women.

The performance is sponsored by the University Committee for Lectures, Films and Concerts and the Student Board of Governors, with the support of the Department of Fine and Performing Arts and the Nebraska Arts Council.
