Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Application

Course Description

The EMT course follows the current 2009 National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, National Emergency Medical Systems Education Standards consisting of approximately 138 classroom hours in addition to performing ten patient assessments. The Creighton University EMS Education Program is approved by the Nebraska Department of Health to provide EMT education. In addition, Creighton University EMS Education is nationally accredited by CAAHEP (Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs) and CoAEMSP (Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the EMS Professions).

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be eligible to complete the National Registry EMT Computer Based Test. Students must have reached 18 years of age in order to take the National Registry examination.

Certification from organizations assessing Cognitive Skills only will not be accepted.
