## Students with 2015 Summer Internships

Sophomore, River Gunville will be attending the Four Directions Summer Research Program at Harvard. This is an 8-week program intended to give minority students an opportunity to build their professional skills and take part in clinical shadowing, and a research project that will be presented at the end of the 8 weeks. Students will have the opportunity to work closely with a faculty member of Harvard Medical School.

Sophomore, Israel Garcia will be attending a 10-week summer internship program at the University of Michigan. The Future Public Health Leaders Program is a CDC funded residential program that runs from late May through early August. The program will include a group community-based research project, field experiences, mentors, workshops/seminars, and field trips. All of which will contribute to a portfolio that each student will create to showcase his or her experience over the course of the 10-week program.
