A Federal Direct Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS) is an unsubsidized loan for the parents of dependent students. PLUS loans help pay for educational expenses up to the cost of attendance minus all other financial assistance. Interest is charged during all periods and repayment normally begins 60 days after the loan is fully disbursed. A FAFSA is required to determine the parents' eligibility.
