Morning Ceremony

Students and processional participants robe and line up at 8:30 a.m. in Hall A of Qwest Center Omaha. The ceremony will begin at 9:30 a.m.

Afternoon Ceremony

Students and processional participants robe and line up at 12:30 p.m. in Hall A of Qwest Center Omaha. The ceremony will begin at 1:30 p.m.

The ceremonies will last approximately two hours.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Caps and gowns for degree candidates have been ordered from the Willsie Cap and Gown Company. Candidates must pick up their caps and gowns in Harper Center Rooms 3028 and 3029 on Thursday, May 12, or Friday, May 13, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Graduates will not be able to pick up their caps and gowns at any other time. Each graduate may keep the cap with tassel, but must return the gown (and hood if a master's or doctor's degree is received) in satisfactory condition to the collection station in Hall A at the Qwest Center Omaha after the ceremony.
