To earn credit for these workshops you must write a half a page summary with the date of the event and email it to Karen or bring it to the office. An example is the Creighton Career Fair, you would write about: what companies you talked with, what you learned, preferred majors, and the type of jobs. Another example is talking with Lisa in the Career Center Office or Dean in the Financial Aid Office, you would write about: what did you enjoy, what happened, skills gained and why are you glad you attended.

If you would like to attend an event not on this list please contact Karen for approval. Even if the event is signed in the notebook, located at the reception desk, without written proof of your attendance in a summary format we can not give you credit.

\*Other ways to earn workshop credit include: completing with Karen a 4 year plan, resume, practice/mock interview, or graduate/professional school application or research. You can also earn workshop credits for participating in the Peer Mentoring Program and Training, four hours of tutoring, campus lectures on careers, apply for an internship, complete a senior check, complete your research or application for graduate school, make a plan for repayment of your college loans, participate in a SSS Service Learning Project, complete a practice interview or write a resume.

\*If you have any questions or concerns, just call or email Karen. SSS is willing to work with you, but if we do not receive a written document from you, you can not get credit. SSS will keep emailing you different events on campus that may count as a workshop, if noted as such in the email.
