TEAM CAPTAIN INFORMATION:

- You will fill out your team roster on the night of your first game. Team rosters must be completed by your third game. On all game nights, please make sure you have your entire playing roster bring their ID's. **All players must have their ID's or they will not play.**
- Team name must conform to the Creighton University Code of Student Conduct and avoid alcohol, drug, demeaning sexual, racial, or other discriminatory references. If team name does not conform, the team name will be changed.
- Before your team purchases uniforms, please be sure to check with the Intramural Director first. Uniforms must comply with the Creighton University Code of Student Conduct also.
- Remind your players that they play at their own risk. Creighton University does not provide additional insurance for their injuries.**
- Team schedules are based on a five game regular season (exceptions: if a league does not fill your team will have a bye or if we have to drop teams do to forfeits). During the regular season your team will play on the same nights but once play-off games begin, your team must be ready to **play on a different night and time. Play-off games are posted on the IM Web Page at the end of the regular season. Play-off games will not be rescheduled. It is highly advised to carry extra players on your roster to avoid possible play-off scheduling conflicts.**
- Players may participate on one (1) men's team or women's team and one (1) Co Rec team only. Please inform all of your players on the team. **PLAYING ON MORE THAN ONE TEAM WILL RESULT IN FORFEITS AND LOSS OF PLAYER ELIGIBILITY.** You are responsible to know the eligibility and game rules. - We strongly discourage forfeits since the reason you want to participate in IM's is to play the games. If your team needs to forfeit a game please call the IM Director ASAP at 280-2987 so he can notify the other team. Remember, a team that forfeits twice will be dropped from the league and be ineligible for the play-offs.
- You may declare to move your team up into a higher play-offs tournament but you will not be able to move down (i.e. TEAM E finishes 2-3 declares to move up to ALL U..... is ok. TEAM G finishes in the Competitive league 1-4 declares to move to Novice....this cannot be done. The Team would have to play in the Competitive play-offs).
- You or one of your team members must attend the captains meeting. Failure to comply will result in your team elimination from the play-offs.**
- Poor player/team conduct will no longer be tolerated. Poor player conduct will result in possible ejections, game forfeitures and elimination from the play-offs.
