Tim Wise

According to Tim's website, "Tim Wise is among the most prominent anti-racist writers and activists in the U.S., and has been called, 'One of the most brilliant, articulate and courageous critics of white privilege in the nation,' by best-selling author and Georgetown professor Michael Eric Dyson. Wise has spoken in 48 states and on over 400 college campuses and has spoken to community groups around the nation. Wise has provided anti-racism training to teachers nationwide, and has trained physicians and medical industry professionals on how to combat racial inequities in health care." Tim is the author of *White Like Me: Reflections on Race from a Privileged Son* and *Affirmative Action: Racial Preference in Black and White*.
