

University Immunization Requirements for 2012-13*

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ALL STUDENTS (Campus Based)	Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)	2 doses MMR vaccine given after the 1 st birthday and at least one month apart are required of all students born after 1957 OR Positive blood tests showing immunity for Measles, Mumps and Rubella History of illness does NOT meet requirement. <u>*Students will not be able to register for 2nd semester classes if not compliant*</u>
ALL RESIDENT STUDENTS (on campus students) DUE BEFORE Move-In *NEW 2012*	Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)	See Above
	Meningitis Vaccine	1 dose Meningitis vaccine given after 16 years of age
	Varicella (Chicken Pox)	Verification of chickenpox disease OR 2 doses Varicella vaccine
	Tdap Vaccine	1 dose Tdap vaccine (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) given after licensure date: May, 2005
INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS	Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)	See Above
	Tuberculosis Screening	Tuberculosis Screening will be done upon arrival to campus unless documentation is provided of a negative PPD skin test done within the past 12 months. *PPD skin test required regardless of prior BCG vaccine. Student with a history of a positive PPD: Chest X-ray done within the past 12 months in the US QuantiFERON Gold testing
Vaccinations Recommended for All College Students	Hepatitis A Hepatitis B	Students who travel or plan to study abroad need both of these vaccines.
	HPV Vaccine	3 dose vaccine series for both male and females 18-26 years of age
	Annual Influenza Vaccine	Annual Flu Vaccine recommended for all college students

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All Health Science Students enrolled in: Dental, EMS, Medical, Nursing, Pharmacy and Health Professions	Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)	2 doses MMR vaccine given after the 1 st birthday and at least one month apart OR Positive blood tests showing immunity for Measles, Mumps and Rubella History of illness does NOT meet requirement
	DPT/Td/Tdap	3-dose series-1 dose must a Tdap vaccine given after licensure in 2005
	Polio	3-dose series OR A positive blood test proving immunity
	Hepatitis B	3-dose series AND A positive blood test proving immunity—Hepatitis B surface antibody test
	Varicella (Chicken pox)	A positive blood test showing immunity OR 2-doses Varicella vaccine
	Tuberculosis Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ●Initial 2-step screening 2 separate PPD skin tests separated by a minimum of 1 week. 2 PPD's in a 12 month period also accepted ●Annual PPD screening ●Students with a history of positive skin tests: Chest x-ray done in US in the past 12 months Annual Provider Review/QuantiFERON Gold
	Annual Influenza vaccine	Annual flu vaccine typically due before December 1

Immunizations will be submitted using the data form provided by individual schools.
