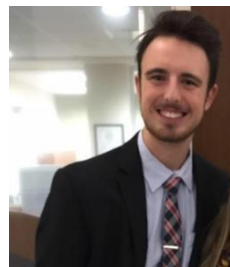

Eligibility Requirements

To participate in recruitment, you must have completed 12 college credit hours and have a **minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5**. If you do not meet these requirements now, we encourage you to go through fall 2018 recruitment.

Attire Guidelines

Formal Events: A suit, tie, and dress shoes are recommended. However, dress pants with a shirt and tie or sweater is acceptable.

Informal Events: Dress for the occasion. If the event is an athletic event then sneakers and clothing that allows for a good range of motion is recommended. Please remember to keep all clothing appropriate.

Creighton Anti-Hazing Statement

The University strictly prohibits hazing - in any form, at any time - including hazing in connection with training, indoctrination, qualification for membership, functions or activities, or initiations conducted or sponsored by any student organization, athletic team, or group of students. Hazing includes any action taken or situation created, whether on or off campus, intended to produce or which may foreseeably produce unusual or unnecessary mental or physical discomfort or pain, embarrassment, harassment, ridicule or risk of physical, mental or emotional harm or injury.

Hazing also includes any action or situation which is intended to be or which may foreseeably be morally, physically, emotionally or mentally degrading to any individual, or which unnecessarily exposes any individual to any risk of physical, mental or emotional harm, injury or distress beyond the risks encountered in ordinary daily life, or which is intended to intimidate or has the effect of intimidating any individual to unwillingly or reluctantly engage in any activity, or which unreasonably interferes with scholastic activities or pursuits of any individual.

One-on-Ones

One on ones are an opportunity for you to get to know members of a chapter in a more casual environment. They are not required, but recommended for any chapters you are interested in or if you miss required events. **If you want to attend a one-on-one you must register.** To register go to the lower SLIC (Skutt Room 120). You must register by 3:30pm the day of the one-on-ones. The last opportunity for a one-on-one is on Saturday, January 20 – you must register for this date by 3:30pm on Friday, January 19.

You will never be expected to miss class or work for a recruitment event. If there is a recruitment event you cannot attend, it is best to inform that chapter's recruitment chair.
