

Immunization Requirements

<p>All Students Full & Part-time</p>	<p>Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)</p>	<p>Two doses MMR vaccine given after the 1st birthday and at least one month apart are required of all Creighton students born after 1957. OR Positive blood tests showing immunity for Measles, Mumps and Rubella are accepted. History of illness does not meet this requirement. <u>* A registration hold will be placed on students who are not compliant.</u></p>
<p>All Health Science Students Dental, EMS, Medical, Nursing Pharmacy & Health Professions</p>	<p>Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)</p>	<p>Two doses MMR vaccine given after the 1st birthday and at least one month apart This is required, regardless of date of birth.</p>
	<p>DPT/Td/Tdap</p>	<p>A three dose series-commonly given in childhood. One dose of Tdap (Adacel or Boostrix) given after licensed in 2005.</p>
	<p>Polio</p>	<p>A three dose series-commonly given in childhood. OR A positive blood test showing immunity for Polio is accepted.</p>
	<p>Hepatitis B</p>	<p>A three dose series AND A positive blood test showing immunity for Hepatitis B. (Hepatitis B surface antibody)</p>
	<p>Varicella (Chicken Pox)</p>	<p>A positive blood test showing immunity is required if student has history of chicken pox. OR If no history of chicken pox, documentation of a two dose series.</p>
<p>Tuberculosis Screening</p>	<p>Initial Screening Two separate PPD skin tests within a one year period of time (2-step testing) Annual screening A single PPD skin test annually after initial screening Students with a history of a positive PPD skin test Chest x-ray done within the past 12 months in the United States AND Annual Provider review OR Annual QuantiFERON Gold testing also accepted</p>	
<p>International Students</p>	<p>Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)</p>	<p>Two doses MMR vaccine given after the 1st birthday and at least one month apart are required of all Creighton students born after 1957. <u>* A registration hold will be placed on students who are not compliant.</u></p>
	<p>Tuberculosis Screening</p>	<p>International Students will be screened upon arrival to campus unless documentation is provided for a negative PPD skin test done within the past 12 months. PPD skin test required regardless of prior BCG vaccine. Students with a history of a positive PPD skin test: Chest x-ray done within the past 12 months in the United States. Annual Provider review QuantiFERON Gold testing also accepted</p>
<p>Recommended for All Students</p>	<p>Hepatitis A</p>	<p>Two dose series given 6-12 months apart. Students who travel or study abroad are encouraged to consider this vaccine.</p>
	<p>Meningitis</p>	<p>This vaccine is especially encouraged for students who will be living in resident halls. Persons traveling to endemic countries also need to consider receiving this vaccine.</p>
	<p>Adacel/Boostrix (Tdap vaccine)</p>	<p>A tetanus booster vaccine with whooping cough coverage is suggested before college.</p>
	<p>Gardasil</p>	<p>A three dose series for females only.</p>
