# Cap and Gown Pickup

Thursday, May 10<sup>th</sup> and Friday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 | 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. | Skutt Student Center, Rooms 104 and 105.

### **BEFORE THE CEREMONY:**

- Please leave valuables at home or with family members. <u>PLEASE REMEMBER THE NEW CLEAR BAG POLICY FOR</u>
   THE CENTURYLINK CENTER. Further information can be found online.
- Please arrive at the CenturyLink Center Omaha at 8:30 a.m. for the 9:30 a.m. ceremony and at 12 p.m. for the 1 p.m. ceremony. You will robe and line up in Hall A which is located off of the Grand Hallway.

- CHECK IN at your school or college check in table immediately inside Hall A.
  - o At your check in table **you will receive a reader card** with your name, degree(s) and a number.
  - o **Line up** in your school's line up area in numerical order **by the number on your card**.
  - DO NOT LOSE THIS CARD. YOU MUST TAKE IT TO THE STAGE TO HAVE YOUR NAME READ.
- Restrooms are at the back of Hall A. Leave plastic and hangers from your regalia in the garbage cans provided in Hall A, not in the restrooms.
- The tassel on your cap goes on the right and stays there until the end of the ceremony when the President will direct all graduates to move it to the left side.
- Professional level and master's level candidates wear their hoods, except Ph.D. candidates; they carry the hood draped over the left forearm for investiture on stage.

#### **DURING THE CEREMONY:**

- An **Associate Marshal** from your school or college **will lead you to your seats** in the arena. **Stay in your line** and in correct order during the procession.
- The faculty and stage party members will process in after you. As a mark of respect, **turn to face the aisles as they process in.**
- When it is time, your Associate Marshal will direct you to line up to cross the stage. Please keep the line
  continuous with no breaks; do not lag behind.
- At the bottom of the stage ramp, **check in with the staff assistant.** At the top of the ramp, **hand your reader card** to the Grand Marshal on stage. **Move forward as soon as your name is announced**.
- Shake hands with the President. Your photo will be taken at that moment.
   Then proceed across the stage to shake hands with your dean and receive your diploma cover.
- After you leave the stage, you will be directed backstage to **have your photo taken**. Marshals backstage will then direct you back around to your seat in the arena.
- Remain in your seat throughout the ceremony. **Please be considerate**; loud cheering for one student often means the name of the next student cannot be heard. Do not throw items or take part in like behaviors.

#### **AFTER THE CEREMONY:**

- MORNING CEREMONY: Graduates will recess out of the arena, led by the Associate Marshals. If you would like to
  take photos with your family while you are still in your regalia, you may do so in the Grand Hallway, but NOT in Hall
  A. Return your regalia and pick up your diploma in Hall A.
- AFTERNOON CEREMONY: Graduates will <u>not</u> recess out of the arena. They will simply stay on the arena floor and
  may greet family there, in the Grand Hallway or in Hall A for photos. Return your regalia and pick up your diploma
  in Hall A by 4:30 p.m.
- You may keep the souvenir mortarboard cap, tassel and hood. Tams and gowns must be turned in.
- If you would like to **purchase your tam**, you may do so when you return your regalia in Hall A. To purchase at a later date, contact Troy Willsie at troygraves@frontiernet.net or call 402.699.1471.
