**Floyd J. Malveaux, MD, PhD, BS'61**

Dr. Floyd Malveaux is a nationally recognized expert in the field of asthma and allergic diseases. His distinguished career is highlighted by nearly six decades at Howard University College of Medicine, where he led initiatives to address asthma morbidity among inner-city children and, in 2005, was appointed dean emeritus. He also has served in a leadership role at the Merck Childhood Asthma Network, Inc. Malveaux has earned many professional awards, has a long history of community service, and has served on Creighton's Board of Trustees since 1997.

**Marjorie K. Leimomi Mala Mau, BS'81, MD'85**  
*School of Medicine*

Dr. Marjorie Mau is professor and founding chair of the Department of Native Hawaiian Health at the John A. Burns School of Medicine, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. Mau is the first Native Hawaiian woman board-certified in both endocrinology and internal medicine and is the first woman to be selected as a master in the American College of Physicians.

She has served as director and principal investigator of the Center for Native and Pacific Health Disparities Research (CNPHDR) since 2002. In collaboration with a team of talented scientists, the CNPHDR has advanced our understanding of diabetes mellitus and metabolic syndrome among Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders, as well as other high-risk populations.
