Floyd J. Malveaux, MD, PhD, BS'61

Dr. Floyd Malveaux is a nationally recognized expert in the field of asthma and allergic diseases. His distinguished career is highlighted by nearly six decades at Howard University College of Medicine, where he led initiatives to address asthma morbidity among inner-city children and, in 2005, was appointed dean emeritus. He also has served in a leadership role at the Merck Childhood Asthma Network, Inc. Malveaux has earned many professional awards, has a long history of community service, and has served on Creighton's Board of Trustees since 1997.

Daniel Hilleman, PharmD'81

Dr. Daniel Hilleman is professor of pharmacy practice and medicine at Creighton University and director of continuing education for the School of Pharmacy and Health Professions. His career as a pharmacist-scientist spans more than 35 years and includes clinical research, clinical teaching, classroom teaching and patient care. He has served as the clinical pharmacist for Creighton's Cardiac Center since 1982.

Hilleman is recognized as an international expert in the field of cardiovascular pharmacotherapy. He also volunteers for a number of pharmacy and cardiology professional organizations and medical journal editorial boards, as well as the Siena/Francis House and Magis Clinic.
