Dear Ministers: A special welcome to all our new ministers and a sincere thank you to those of you who continue to serve the people of St. John's during our Sunday liturgies! *Vivian will be the sacristan for this mass. Please check with her for anything you may need.*
Thanks so much!

Here are a few items to note concerning your ministries that help all of us to serve the people of St John's well!

All Lectors and Leaders of Prayers:

- All lectors have been placed in the rotation as Leader of the Prayers – hopefully this will help everyone with everyone serving more often!
- Please sign in at the main entrance of church at least 10 minutes before Mass starts
- **All readers** are asked to take part in the **Opening Procession**.
 - First Lector carries the Book of the Gospel – places it on the altar – steps back and bows – proceed to seat
 - The Second Lector and the Leader of Prayers – follows side by side – Wait at the base of the steps for the Gospel Book to be placed then bow and proceed to your seats
- Closing Procession – You Do NOT need to process out.
- Some Lector Workbooks have been ordered (They will be here by Advent) – If you would like one of your own please donate \$11.00 and take one
- Otherwise, the readings for the weekend can be found at the following website:
www.creighton.edu/CollaborativeMinistry/daily.html Just click on the date and it will take you to the reflection. Then click on the references for the readings and it will take you right to them.

Eucharistic Ministers

- **Please sign in at the main entrance** of the church when you first arrive.
- If you are not signed in at least 3-5 minutes before the start of mass we will begin to fill the positions
- **PLEASE** – Everyone move to form an arc close behind the altar **at the BEGINNING of the Sign of Peace!** ~ This prevents ministers moving during the Fraction Rite and the “Lamb of God”.

- **If you are serving the sanctuary area, please make sure that the choir including Tony gets both the host and wine.**
- **AFTER communion** just place your vessel on the credence table and move immediately to your seats.
- **After MASS**, EME come to the credence table or sacristy to help consume any precious blood that might be left and purify the vessels. Afterwards join the other ministers in the sacristy to wash the cups with soap and water! This takes only a couple of minutes and it's also a lot of fun. This has been working well at all other Masses.

TO ALL NEW MINISTERS: If you still need to be trained please contact Sr. Donna Marie before you serve!

- Close to the start of Mass (3 minutes) **Check to see if we still need ministers** - even when you are not scheduled. If there is an empty spot go ahead and sign in!!! (This helps a lot)
- Serve the choir after all other people have been served. Check with the sacristan if you have any questions!! Thanks.
