

Forst Receives Creighton University School of Pharmacy and Health Professions Alumni Merit Award

Christopher J. Forst, BSPha'81, received the 2012 School of Pharmacy and Health Professions Alumni Merit Award at the University's annual Alumni Weekend in Omaha on Sept. 21, 2012.

Forst, from Dublin, Ohio, received his bachelor of science from the school of Pharmacy and Health Professions in 1981. As a Creighton student he was an awarding-winning leader in the American Pharmacists Association (APhA) student chapter where he served as president and chapter delegate. He was also awarded the Nebraska Society of Hospital Pharmacists Student Award.

Forst was named a Fellow in 1999 by the APhA for his outstanding service and clinical career. Throughout his career Forst held many national positions within the APhA including a place in the Academy of Pharmacy Practice and Management executive committee and the House of Delegates. He currently serves as the director at Supply Chain Integrity and Regulatory Operations.

Forst believes strongly in mentoring and encouraging students and has endowed a scholarship in the School of Pharmacy and Health Professions in his parents' name.
