PURPOSE

This policy outlines the expectations for comparability of assessment across campuses.

POLICY

For required courses, all assessment methods and instruments identified in the syllabus as components of the course grade will be the same on both campuses.

PROCEDURE

The course directors and the blue, green, and gold track directors will be responsible for reviewing and assuring the same assessments are used on each campus.

For gross anatomy lab practical exams, equivalency will be achieved by the anatomy discipline stewards sharing a detailed list of taggable structures and discussing acceptable answers.

SCOPE

All required courses within the Medical Education Program.

ADMINISTRATION AND INTERPRETATION

The Senior Director of Program Assessment and Curriculum Development will be responsible for:

- a. monitoring adherence to the policy
- b. notifying the Educational Policy Committee of non-compliance.

AMENDMENT

This policy may be amended by majority vote of the School of Medicine Medical Education Program Educational Program Committee.
