PURPOSE

The M3 Clerkship Remediation Guideline details the process followed if a student completing the M3 curriculum receives a final grade of Unsatisfactory (UN) for a clerkship and/or selective.

GUIDELINE

Students who receive a final grade of Unsatisfactory (UN) for a M3 clerkship and/or M3 selective, are required to repeat the clerkship and/or selective during the course's regular scheduled course dates only.

PROCEDURE

- A. Failure of a M3 clerkship:
 Students who fail a M3 clerkship are required to repeat the clerkship during its regular scheduled course dates
- B. Failure of a M3 selective: Students who fail a M3 selective are required to repeat the selective during its regular scheduled course dates.

SCOPE

All students enrolled in the medical education program.
