Your child is eligible if they:

What will be done during this research study?

You and your child will be asked to come to the Rehabilitation Lab at Creighton University for a one-hour session. Your child will be asked to stand on a force plate (used for measuring posture) with eyes open and eyes closed, or while standing on a foam mat or while wearing a paper hat that also covers the eyes on the head (pictured above).

In order to maximize the comfort and safety of you and your child, you will be allowed to always be next to your child during measurement. During downtime, toys and music are provided to help keep your child comfortable and entertained.
