“the same Spirit could inspire me to take one point of view for some reasons and inspire others to the contrary for other reasons.”




It is sometimes difficult for individuals, cities, or countries to invite disagreement because they lack the knowledge of how to speak constructively about their differences and, how to resolve those differences.
