A Note from the Chair

Dear Alumni:



We had a very successful spring semester and finished the year with 232 majors! Commencement was just two weeks ago and 66 majors received their diploma, many of whom will continue their education in one of Creighton's professional schools next fall. In fact, 97% (32/33) of our graduating seniors who applied to professional or graduate school were accepted into a program of their choice including physical therapy; occupational therapy; medicine; dentistry; graduate school; accelerated nursing, and optometry. Several others are taking a gap year in further preparation for professional school and will apply next year. Others are already working in health-related jobs, one will be teaching high school students in New Mexico as part of Teach for America, and we also had three students commissioned as second Lieutenants in the US Army. An amazing group of seniors!

Several faculty were also recognized this spring for their years of service at Creighton including Dr. Dimitrios Katsavelis (5 yr), Dr. Patrick Lambert (15 yr), Ms. Jennifer Yee (20 yr), and Dr. Tom Baechle (40 yr). Dr. Baechle completed a sabbatical in the spring working on a 6th edition of his book, 'Weight Training: Steps to Success,' and recently announced that he will retire after this summer. We're going to miss him and are grateful for his vision, leadership, and will do our very best to continue the legacy he is leaving behind. A reception in his honor is in the planning stages for early fall, so stay tuned for future announcements.

Lastly, six of our junior and senior students are presenting posters at ACSM this year under the direction of Dr. Eric Bredahl and Dr. Jake Siedlik. 




St. Albert's Day & EXS 407 Research Presentation Day
