Cyber Training

All employees are required to finish Security Awareness Training before April 9, 2018 this quarter. Log In with your Creighton credentials here.

NOTE: Email is the method used for Creighton employee information. Please check your Creighton Email at least once a week.

Evaluate Your Retirement Readiness

Is determining your retirement readiness one of your New Year's resolutions? If so, a Principal representative will be on campus the 9th through 12th; click here to sign up. TIAA plan participants can click here to sign up and meet with your representative on Jan 11th.

Form 1095-C

Employers are required to furnish eligible employees with the Form 1095-C on or before March 2nd. This form is required under the Affordable Care Act and reports your enrollment in affordable health coverage. While it is not required to have this form to file your taxes, it is recommended you keep the form with your other 2017 tax forms once received. Have questions? Creighton's Contribution to Your Health Savings Account (HSA)

Creighton contribution to your HSA (\$500 for employee only or \$750 for family) will be made in January for the 2018 plan year. Biweekly employees will receive their contribution on January 26th and monthly paid employees will receive theirs on January 31st. All contributions should be posted to your HSA account 2-3 business days after your respective pay date. Please check your account at www.payflex.com to ensure funds are available before processing payments.

Earth Week Celebrations will Occur on Campus from April 16 through April 20

Earth Day occurs annually on April 22. Every year, Creighton celebrates with awareness raising events and service. Students, faculty and staff who are interested in planning activities for Earth Week April 16-22, are encouraged to attend this initial planning session.

2017 Tree Campus USA

In December of 2017 Creighton University completed its application seeking a 10th year of recognition as a Tree Campus USA site. As part of the reporting required for this designation, tree plantings and removals are tracked. Following is a table summarizing 2017:

New Trees planted	78
Trees removed	64
Net loss/gain of trees	14

The overall goal is to maintain or increase the number of trees on campus, and 2017 resulted in a net gain of 14 trees. This is an improvement over 2016, which saw a net loss of 14 trees, mostly due to the removal of trees that were not correctly sited (and thus were not candidates for replanting).

The table below summarizes causes of the 2017 removals:

Reason for removal	Number of trees removed
Disease/Pest (direct)	3
Construction (direct)	44
Vandalism	0
Structural instability	0
General Decline/Death	8

Sixty-four trees were removed in 2017, significantly more than the 28 removed in 2016. This is due to a large number of trees being removed from the site of the School of Dentistry building that is under construction on Cuming Street between 23rd Street and 21st Street. Warm weather that continued late into fall allowed many of the trees that are part of the new building's landscape to be planted before year's end, allowing us to show favorable numbers for the overall campus tree population.

Losses due to disease in 2017 were specifically attributed to fire blight (2) and black knot (1).

Removals attributed to general decline and deaths are caused by a wide range of factors. Examples of these factors are:

- Indirect construction impacts, such as root compaction from vehicle/equipment traffic, storage of materials, and root damage due to trenching or digging.
- Cultural issues such as drought, winter injury, and poor drainage.

The effect of this type of damage to a tree is not immediate or obvious but instead occurs over several years following the damaging event. Often, more than one of these factors or events contributes to the tree's gradual decline and eventual death.

It is expected that Creighton will again be awarded Tree Campus USA recognition for its 2017 application. This will be the 10th year of recognition for the University. Confirmation will come in April of this year.
