Comments

- The overall percentage of successful outcomes nine months after graduation is more than 90% for all undergraduate colleges. This is significantly higher than the national placement rate of college graduates nine months after graduation.
- These data are based on an 80% response rate of graduates from DEC, 2009 through AUG, 2010. This response rate is much higher than that of the national average reported by most career centers.
- Enrollment in graduate and professional school programs for graduates in the College of Arts and Sciences is 52%. As in most years, this percentage exceeds 60% when including graduates that pursue advanced study one year after completion of their undergraduate degree.
- Salary averages for undergraduates are very competitive with national salary data despite geographic placements primarily being in locations where the cost of living is much lower and entry-level salaries for college students are lower than the national averages.

Special Note: Despite the challenges in the current economy, campus recruiting activity of employers that hire Creighton interns and graduates did not slow in the past year. In fact, the number of internships and full-time positions listed by employers on the Career Center website increased in the past year which is further evidence of continue employer preference for hiring Creighton students and recent alumni.
