**51%**

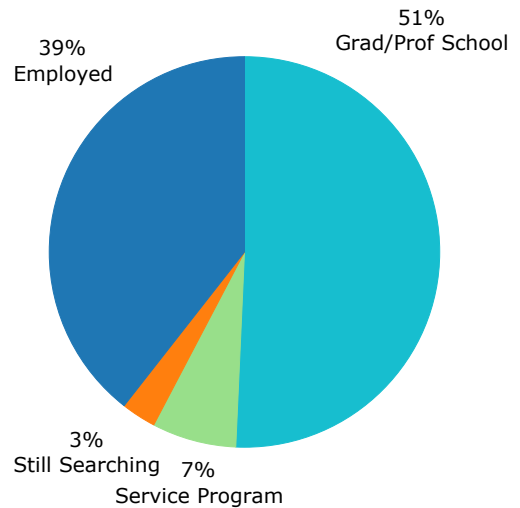
participated in at least one internship. Many students completed more than one internship, some up to 4 or 5.

engaged in both an internship and a research experience. Students interned and conducted research in Nebraska, nationally, and internationally.

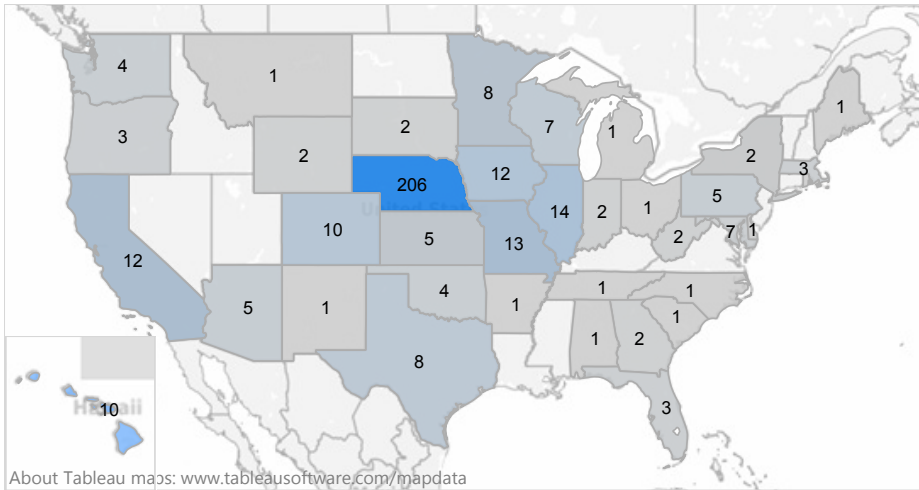
