The Traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program prepares graduates for entry-level professional nursing practice in both hospital and community-based settings. By preparing nurses who are strong in both theoretical knowledge and clinical skills, Creighton BSN graduates continue to exceed the national average for first-time pass rates on the national licensing exam.

Creighton Nursing majors learn how to manage and improve care outcomes by gaining experience in a myriad of clinical settings - critical care, community-based care, public health, pediatrics, and behavioral health. Nearly 100% of all BSN graduates from Creighton are employed either by graduation or within 3 months. And just as nursing majors gain experience in a variety of clinical settings during their undergraduate studies, they also go on to garner meaningful employment all across the country in virtually every hospital department as well as community practices and private settings. A representative listing of these placements is provided here from data gathered from graduates from the years 2010-2011. Additionally, a handful of students go on to graduate level nursing or nurse practitioner programs.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the median annual wage of registered nurses was \$64,690 in May 2010.
