- Creighton and CHI Health partnered to create a one-of-a-kind academic medical center that includes:
 - > An ambulatory center near Creighton with primary, secondary and emergency care that stresses community health, wellness and health promotion
 - > Inpatient services and Level 1 trauma in central Omaha
- Creighton is constructing a new health sciences campus in Phoenix expanding existing relationships, providing new opportunities for our students, and meeting a critical need for health care professionals in the Southwest

Our faculty and research are world-renowned

- Research awards for the most recent fiscal year totaled \$10.6 million
- The medical school is an international leader in hereditary cancer and osteoporosis
- Other outstanding programs include infectious disease, cardiovascular disease, nutrition/ metabolism and neuroscience
- A landmark study conducted at Creighton suggests that boosting vitamin D3 intake can significantly reduce risk of breast and other cancers
- Researchers in biomedical sciences, medical microbiology/immunology and pharmacology are making discoveries in atherosclerosis, bacterial resistance, cancer, hearing restoration, brain injury, bone growth/bone loss and more
