Include: All affiliations with foreign entities or governments All titled academic, professional, or institutional appointments For both categories, indicate whether remuneration is received and whether the position is full-time, part-time, or voluntary (including adjunct, visiting, or honorary)	Required
Section C: Contribution to Science	
No updates or changes to instructions	Required
Section D: Research Support	
	Removed for research applications (some information can still be included in Section A) Scholastic Performance still required for Fellowship applications
