Volunteers Needed for Research

Marc Rendell, MD is conducting a research study at the Creighton Diabetes Center

This study is for people who are at risk for developing major cardiovascular events, such as heart attack, stroke or hospitalization for chest pain.

We are looking for people who meet the following criteria:

1. People who have had a previous heart attack or stroke or have diabetes, kidney disease, hardening of the arteries of the legs or an inherited disorder of high cholesterol.
2. People must be over 19.
3. Must have been using one of the following medications at least 6 weeks prior to screening: atorvastatin, 40 or 80 mg once a day; rosuvastatin, 20 or 40 mg once a day; simvastatin, 40 mg or 80 mg once a day. Combination medications are acceptable. Under certain circumstances alternative treatments will be accepted.
