1) This fall/winter, it seemed like there were a LOT of calls for donations of various things - coats for Yates, "stuff" for ILAC, etc etc etc. Is there some way of consolidating all of these things or publishing ahead of time a list of who is going to need what? It seems like the last ones to announce would get the least donations, PLUS there's donation fatigue if we're constantly being asked for things.

The Staff Advisory Council will collect several times per year depending on the community need. In the past we have had a fall- backpack campaign that assist's The Salvation Army in collecting school supplies for those students in need, a collection around the holiday season (Thanksgiving/Christmas) and usually a spring donation of some sort which also depends on the need of the community.

This 2016/2017 we decided to assist the SCSJ with their events instead of doing separate ones. Also since Creighton hosted the Opus Prize we held a special collection in their honor but will not be an annual event. To not overwhelm the Creighton community with donation fatigue, we will limit the collection to 3-4 times yearly.
