Nursing Notes – Admit Day 4:

0700: Answered call light. Hazel awake after restless night. Some confusion noted. Orientated to person and place, but not date and time. Hazel transferred to bedside commode using one assist and gait belt. No other assistive devices used for ambulation or transfers.

0830: Breakfast tray removed from room. Only 25% of meal eaten, consistent with past meals and Hazel's recent appetite. Assisted Hazel to shower. Shower chair and grab bars used. Frequent rest breaks required. Hazel needed assistance with washing and dressing due to fatigue and shortness of breath. Visited about how Hazel manages these tasks at home. Hazel indicated that she has grab bars at home, but no shower chair.

1000: Son stopped by, brought playing cards and a book he thought Hazel would enjoy. Hazel is disinterested, also declining ambulation in the hall. Hazel expressed concern about how she will attend church services if she is not able to tolerate leaving her home. Coping support offered. Bradley reported that Hazel had confusion with current events during his visit, such as thinking his wife is with him on this trip, forgetting she is in California and did not come with him this time (despite multiple reminders).
