## **PURPOSE**

The School of Medicine (hereafter, School) and its clinical affiliates have identified certification in basic life support and advanced cardiac life support as a critical competency for medical practice.

## **POLICY**

All students are required to become certified in Basic Life Support (BLS) during the Component I year and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) during the Component III year. The Medical Education Program will pay for recertification examinations for whose certifications elapses before graduation.

#### **SCOPE**

All students enrolled in the Medical Education Program.
