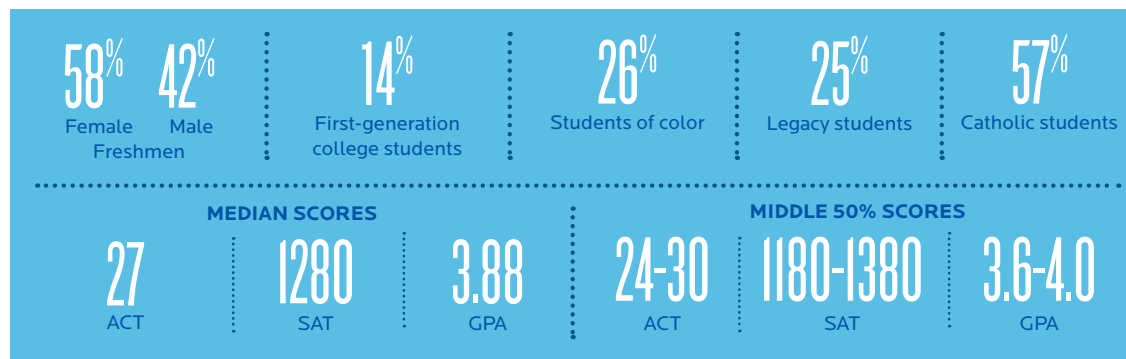

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

99 percent of our students receive some form of the following types of aid:

- Need-based financial aid – scholarships, grants, loans, work study
- Non-need-based aid – academic merit scholarships and loans
- Athletic scholarships
- ROTC scholarships

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

- **Completed Application for Admission**
- **Personal Statement/Essay**
- **Official transcripts and grading scale** (sent directly from your high school)
Transfer students must also include transcripts from all colleges or universities attended.
- **High School Counselor Evaluation**
Transfer students must submit a college official's report to confirm good standing at your previous institution(s).
- **ACT or SAT I Scores***
For students submitting test scores, writing scores are not required for ACT/SAT.
- **Teacher recommendation(s)**
Optional—may be teacher, mentor, advisor, etc.

**Creighton is a test-optional institution. Applicants who feel their ACT or SAT score does not accurately reflect their ability to be successful at Creighton may elect to apply test-optional.*

TIMELINE

NOVEMBER 1

Early action deadline. This non-binding deadline means that applications submitted and completed by **November 1** will be reviewed first and receive an admissions decision by **December 15**.

DECEMBER 1

Priority deadline for scholarship consideration. To be eligible for scholarship consideration, the completed Application for Admission, including all required materials, must be received by the Admissions Office no later than **December 1**. Admission decisions are made on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified 4-6 weeks after their application has been completed.

JANUARY 5

Completed Additional Scholarship and Special Program Application deadline. Additional Scholarship Applications can be found online at choose.creighton.edu.

JANUARY 15

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Preferred Deadline to be considered for the maximum amount of need-based aid (Creighton, federal, state and private).

MAY 1

Class reservation, housing contract, and deposit deadline. Complete your class reservation form at choose.creighton.edu/status.
