PURPOSE

This policy provide explanation why students are not allowed to be employed during the medical education program.

POLICY

The curriculum of the School of Medicine requires the full-time effort and energy of all medical students. Since it is believed that outside work interferes greatly with medical education, such work is not allowed. Students may receive grant money for research that would lead to scholarly output for the student. Any exception must be approved by the Associate Dean for Student Affairs. Summer employment is permitted following the M1 year.
