### **PURPOSE**

The house staff physician shall remain free to utilize his/her off-duty time as he/she deems appropriate, so long as such activity does not interfere with the ability of the resident to achieve the goals and objectives of the educational program and must not interfere with the resident's fitness for work nor compromise patient safety. All moonlighting and volunteering hours must be counted towards the 80- hour maximum weekly duty hour limit.

### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to all Creighton University **Interventional Cardiology fellows**

### **POLICY**

Moonlighting is permitted for with the stipulation that it DOES NOT interfere with your duties as a fellow in the Interventional Cardiovascular Training Program. Fellowship responsibilities MAY NOT take second place to outside activities. If moonlighting responsibilities are found to interfere with the Training Program, discontinuation will be required. Internal moonlighting will be considered as part of the 80-hour work week.

All moonlighting jobs must be approved by the Program Director prior to the starting date. The forms are available in the Program Coordinator's office and a copy of one is found in the "forms" section of your handbook.
