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PURPOSE

In compliance with the ACGME Institutional and Common Program Requirements, it is the goal of Creighton University to outline the process for requesting moonlighting or volunteer activities to the residents in the Diagnostic Radiology Residency Program at Creighton University School of Medicine (Phoenix)

SCOPE

This policy applies to all residents in the Diagnostic Radiology Residency Program at Creighton University School of Medicine (Phoenix)

POLICY

The departmental policy on Moonlighting and Volunteering is outlined below, along with a link to access Creighton University GME policy.

Residency training is a full-time educational experience. It is the policy of our program that resident moonlighting and volunteer activities must not interfere with a resident's professional development or duties within the entire framework of the training program.

MOONLIGHTING & VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

Extramural paid activities (internal and external moonlighting) must not interfere with the resident's educational performance, clinical duties or clerical responsibilities; nor must those activities interfere with the resident's opportunities for rest, relaxation and independent study.

- This program does not require residents to engage in moonlighting or volunteering.
- The resident must complete the required Moonlighting and Volunteer Activity Report (MAR) which are only valid for the current academic year and must be renewed prior to July 1st of each academic year. These must be on file with the Graduate Medical Office (GME). They must have program director approval each year and be in good academic standing to moonlight or volunteer.
- Moonlighting and volunteering is considered part of a resident's work hours and must be recorded in New Innovations regularly, due the 7th of each month.
- The program will always closely monitor each resident's performance and adherence to work hour policy, including moonlighting and volunteer activities. Moonlighting (Internal and External) and Volunteering count toward all ACGME Work Hour Rules.
- The Resident is responsible for obtaining a state medical license, DEA number and liability insurance for external moonlight activities as these are not covered under the scope of residency training activities. They cannot use the licensing provided by the program as residents in training for this purpose.
- Any resident who fails to follow this policy will be sanctioned for such actions including suspension and/or dismissal from the residency program.

In the event of any discrepancies between program policies and the GME policy, the GME policy shall govern.
