PURPOSE

In compliance with the ACGME Institutional and Common Program Requirements, it is the goal of Creighton University to outline the departmental policy on Moonlighting and Medical Volunteer Activities for residents in the Creighton University School of Medicine (Phoenix) Surgical Critical Care Fellowship Program.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all surgical critical care fellows under the sponsorship of Creighton University School of Medicine/ (Phoenix) Program.

DEFINITIONS

- Moonlighting as referred to in this policy, is defined as holding one or more paying jobs or positions outside of the surgical fellowship position.
- Medical Volunteering as referred to in this policy is defined as providing medical care to underserved populations or communities in which service and time is given free of charge or payment.

GENERAL POLICY

- Moonlighting during surgical fellowship training at Creighton University is **not permitted**.
- Moonlighting is not required by the program or Creighton University.
- Volunteer activities are **not required** by the program of Creighton University.
