PURPOSE

In compliance with the ACGME Institutional and Common Program Requirements, it is the goal of Creighton University to outline the departmental policy on Moonlighting and Volunteer Activities for residents at Creighton University School of Medicine (Phoenix) Surgery Residency Program.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all surgery residents under the sponsorship of Creighton University School of Medicine (Phoenix) Program.

DEFINITIONS

Moonlighting: Moonlighting, as referred to in this policy, is defined as holding one or more paying jobs or positions in addition to one's work as a physician of the surgical residency position.

Volunteering: An activity when a resident works in a medical professional capacity off-duty for no compensation.

GENERAL POLICY

- 1. Moonlighting during surgical residency training is not permitted.
- 2. Moonlighting is not required by the program or its participating sites.
- 3. Surgery residents do not generally participate in volunteering.
