Popular neighborhood for going out to eat, shopping, and nightlife. Host of a Saturday morning farmer's market.



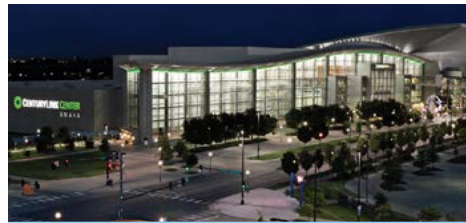
Bob Kerry Pedestrian Bridge
