Summer Health Program

The **flagship program of Creighton-ILAC**, this inter-disciplinary program gives students and professionals in the fields of nursing, dentistry, pharmacy, and medicine the opportunity to build relationships across cultural, linguistic, and socio-economic barriers and creates the opportunity for Dominicans living in rural communities to receive basic health care.



Water Quality Program

While spending time in rural campo communities, students analyze water samples and filters in homes and build community with fellow students and Dominicans. In forming these relationships, students experience service that is not about serving the community, but rather about **serving with the community and creating a shared sense of dignity and accomplishment.**



OT / PT Immersions

These immersion programs work in close collaboration with partner organizations in the Dominican Republic to allow Creighton Occupational and Physical Therapy students the opportunity to work alongside and learn from locals in these fields. Throughout the programs, **students and professionals alike engage in active reflection** about the culture and personal growth from the experience.
