



COVID-19 Checklist

What if I'm feeling ill or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms?

1. If you are feeling ill, **DO NOT COME TO CAMPUS.**
2. Notify your instructors and/or supervisors regarding your absence.
3. If you have symptoms that are consistent with possible COVID-19 infection, please follow the guidance below.

- > Obtain a COVID-19 test. (See testing options below.)
- > Wear a face covering, stay home and separate yourself from other people, pending your test result.
- > Contact your health care provider or the [CHI Health Clinic – Student Care Clinic](#) and follow the directives of your health care provider.

Testing Options

- > Low or no-cost COVID-19 tests are available at [health centers and select pharmacies nationwide](#). For more information locally, visit the [Douglas County Health Department website](#) (Omaha), the [Maricopa County website](#) (Phoenix) or [CHI Health Clinic – Student Care Clinic](#) (Omaha).
- > [TotalWellness](#) is offering COVID-19 testing in Omaha, by appointment, at 9324 H Court. Testing is free through insurance.
- > Creighton is working with CHI Health to provide convenient, accessible COVID-19 testing at the Student Care Clinic adjacent to campus. Students can call the Student Care Clinic at 402.280.2735 (option 2) to make an appointment with a provider, or, if registered with CHI's My Chart Patient Portal, use that system to report their symptoms and request a COVID-19 test. All provider appointments and COVID-19 testing charges will be billed to your insurance. More detailed information is available on the COVID-19 website under "Testing and Vaccinations."
