**1. As a contributed services faculty member, if I choose not to get the COVID-19 vaccine, could I test weekly instead?**

Under federal guidelines, all Creighton University employees (including contributed service faculty) are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or have an approved religious or medical exemption. Those with approved exemptions must submit to weekly COVID-19 testing. The University is currently reviewing the best process to satisfy the testing requirement. More information will be forthcoming.

The University asks employees seeking a COVID-19 vaccination exemption to complete a [Medical Exemption Request](#) or the [Religious Exemption Request](#), and email the completed and **signed** form to [EmployeeExemptions@creighton.edu](mailto:EmployeeExemptions@creighton.edu). **2. Does Creighton require face coverings at athletic events?**

Yes. Effective Jan. 7, face coverings are required in all athletic venues, including D.J. Sokol Arena and CHI Health Center Omaha. This University requirement will continue through Jan. 31, at which time Creighton will reassess its protocols. There is also a temporary indoor face covering mandate for the city of Omaha, which began Jan. 12.

**3. Does the vaccine requirement for employees apply to part-time employees and volunteer faculty?**

Yes, the requirement applies to all Creighton employees, including part-time and volunteer employees.

**4. Do I need to send proof of COVID-19 booster vaccinations to the Birdhouse?**
