Prerequisites and Notes
Juvenile Justice Clinic. See Professor Suder.
Legal Clinic. See Professor Uchimiya.
P: LRWI and LRWII
Limited to students selected by Prof. Mangrum based on trial competition. You will be registered for this by Kris Victor upon her receipt of names from Professor Mangrum.
P: Civ Pro I and II; Evidence
P: Business Associations and Federal Income Tax. This course is recommended for 3L students.
P: Contracts I and II; Commercial Law recommended.
P: Contracts I and II
Available to 3Ls only; required for bottom third of 3L class.
P: Civ Pro I and II
P: Constitutional Law
P: Constitutional Law; Criminal Law; Evidence; Civ Pro I and II. Prerequisites may be taken concurrently with this course. If you also take Prosecution of Criminal Cases, only one class will count for the Criminal Law Area of Concentration credit requirement.
P: Trusts and Estates, Federal Income Tax; Estate and Gift Taxation
Please contact Professor Uchimiya if you are interested in enrolling in an externship. Federal externships may not be available unless you apply early.
Three non-classroom credits are earned for the externship and one credit is earned for this classroom component. Externship students completing more than one externships only need to take the classroom component once.
P: Evidence, Trust and Estates; Federal Income Tax; Marriage and Divorce; or special permission from Professor Brooks if prerequisites not met.
P: Constitutional Law
Four credits total; three for clinic and one for classroom component. Must also take LAW 422. P: Students must have completed four semesters of law school or the equivalent of 56 credit hours and have approval from Professor Suder. A background check is required.
Students who have taken Juvenile Law may not register for this course.
P: Business Associations
Four credits total; three for clinic and one for classroom component. Must also take LAW 522. P: Students must have completed four semesters of law school or the equivalent of 56 credit hours and have approval from Professor Uchimiya
P: Approval from Professor Uchimiya
