

## **COVID-19 Checklist**

## What if I test positive for COVID-19?

- 1. DO NOT COME TO CAMPUS. (If you live on campus, remain in your residence hall room.)
- 2. Notify your instructors and/or supervisors regarding your absence and return.
- 3. Work with your health care provider for specific directives (students also can contact the CHI Health Clinic Student Care Clinic)
- 4. Isolate according to the guidance below.

## All students, faculty and staff

- > Isolate for a minimum of 5 days.
  - Isolation days are counted from the date of symptom onset, OR from the date of a positive result if you are asymptomatic.
  - Consider the date of symptom onset or positive test result as day 0.
- If after 5 days you are asymptomatic or your symptoms are resolving (fever-free for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medications), you can discontinue isolation, but should continue to wear a face covering when around others for an additional 5 days to minimize the risk of transmission. Students, faculty and staff who work with patients in a health care setting are required to wear an N95.
- > There is no requirement to obtain a negative COVID-19 test prior to returning to work or school.
- > If after 5 days your symptoms are not resolving, continue to isolate until symptoms have improved and you are fever-free for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medications.
- > If after 10 days your symptoms are not resolving, continue to isolate until symptoms have improved and you are fever-free for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medications, and contact your health care provider or the CHI Health Clinic Student Care Clinic.
- > If you are involved in clinical work in a health care setting, consult with your clinical location for further guidance and follow the more stringent guidelines.

Students should notify Student Health Education and Compliance (<u>StudentHealth@creighton.edu</u>) if they need to be absent for an extended time beyond the isolation period.
